CODE OF CONDUCT FOR VOLUNTEERS, ASSISTANTS & OFFICIALS

This is the adopted policy of the UK Tae Kwon Do Commission and is to be implemented and adhered to in all member clubs and organisations.

**The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarized below
All volunteers, officials and representatives must:**

- Consider the wellbeing and safety of participants before the development of performance.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with participants, based on mutual trust and respect.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part.
- Promote the positive aspects of the Martial Arts through courtesy and respect as well as the principles of fair play and natural justice.
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- Follow all guidelines laid down by UKCDKT as a national governing body and the member club.
- Hold appropriate valid qualifications and insurance cover.
- Never exert undue influence over participants to obtain personal benefit or reward.
- Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibited substances.
- Encourage participants to value their performances and not just results.
- Encourage and guide participants to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
